COMMUNITY

Members of the community - who may be men or women, single or married - commit voluntarily to a shared goal and shared values. The aim of living together (as it is for SDG members) is the practice of the great commandment: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." (Luke 10:27)

PRAYER

Prayer brings order into the daily rhythm and work. The prayer times are Scripture centered but liturgical structure, singing, silence and intercession are also important.

WORK

The manual work sustains the place and the community and provides for the guests while it is in harmony with the surrounding natural environment.

GUESTS

Hospitality is a fundamental service of the community. Our programs are organized in order to create an opportunity for individual and shared experience of retreat, primarily to nourishment a relationship with God.

CHURCH

The community is independent as an organization, yet we are linked to the Hungarian Reformed Church, which we aim to support and enrich.
